New in this Release

The following new features were released in OneDrive Connector version 12.12.0.

- The configuration parameters DriveUrlCantHaveRegex and DriveUrlMustHaveRegex have been added, so that you can choose the drives to synchronize by matching drive URLs.
- The configuration parameters FileMetadataCantHaveName, FileMetadataCantHaveRegex, FileMetadataMustHaveName, and FileMetadataMustHaveRegex have been added, so that you can ignore documents based on metadata field values.

Resolved Issues

The following issues were resolved in OneDrive Connector version 12.12.0.

- A SynchronizeGroups task could fail if the connector encountered a group without a display name. The connector now logs a warning, skips that group, and continues processing.
- (Security update) The third-party OpenSSL library has been upgraded to version 1.1.1n to resolve a security vulnerability, CVE-2022-0778.
