New in this Release

The following new features were released in Lithium Connector version 12.5.0.

- The connector retrieves information from Lithium through the Lithium version 2.0 REST API. The
 connector can now retrieve additional metadata for messages, including information about
 associated attachments.
- The connector can obtain details about your HTTP proxy from the system. Instead of setting ProxyHost, ProxyPort, ProxyUsername, and ProxyPassword, you can set the new configuration parameter UseSystemProxy to TRUE.

Resolved Issues

The following issues were resolved in Lithium Connector version 12.5.0.

• The connector failed to re-authenticate when the session expired, when Lithium authentication was used.

Notes

This section contains information that is important if you are upgrading from an earlier version of Lithium Connector.

- The connector now retrieves information using the Lithium version 2.0 REST API, resulting in the following changes:
 - Document references for messages are now in the format /messages/XXXXXX rather than messages/id/XXXXXX.
 - Document references for attachments are now in the format /messages/XXXXXX/attachments/XXX rather than messages/id/XXXXXX/upload/attachments/XXX.
 - There are significant changes to the format of document metadata, when compared to previous versions of the connector.
 - In the response of the identifiers fetch action, the identifier type "Thread" has been removed. The root message of a topic now has the type "Message".
