Silk Central 21.1 Release Notes

Version 21.1

What's New in Silk Central 21.1

Silk Central 21.1 introduces significant enhancements and changes.

Administration

Permissions

Manage project settings permission is required now for editing the custom panel information, instead of **Manage Project** permission. Additionally, **Change finished component status** permission was added in **Execution** category for changing finished components status.

Filtering

Status Reason & Run Comment

Tests can be filtered by the **Status Reason** or the **Run Comment** of their last execution. Requirements can be filtered by the Status Reason or the Run Comment of their assigned tests. These filtering criteria can be used also when creating reports.

NOT logic in filters

When creating or editing a filter or a report, there is a **NOT** checkbox which can be used to negate the logic of the filter. This will be applied to the properties operators and to the AND/OR logic. The checkbox will also negate the logic of the nested filters.

Tests and Execution Planning

Business Process Tests

Statuses of finished components tests can be edited in the **Finished components** dialog. Also, components assignment updates can be now synchronized as well.

Tests and Execution Plans Attributes

Attributes page grid contains two new columns which indicates if an attribute is used in tests or execution plans.

Excel

The full path from Silk Central is displayed in the **FullPath** column when exporting tests to Excel. The path is also displayed in the **Tests Document View** in the **Path** column.

Tests Grid View

Tests Grid View can display new properties: Status Reason, Run Comment. Other than that, the workflow state of tests can be now edited from the Tests grid view.

Show only issues in current run

In the **Manual Test results view** can be displayed only issues which are in the current run by checking the **Show issues in current run** checkbox.

Reports

Global Search

The global search allows the user to perform a search on the reports and their description now. The search results include also reports from **Issue Manager**.

Issue Manager

Custom Fields

Custom required fields are displayed in the newly created section on issue details, in order to be highlighted, so the customer can be aware of them. Also, a maximum of 100 custom fields can be configured instead of 40.

Issue Notifications

New users are now notified by default if an issue in their inbox is modified or reassigned and when an issue is assigned to them.

Issue Tracking Profiles

Issue Tracking Profiles grid has a new column from which an issue tracking profile can be activated or deactivated. Inactive profiles can no longer be selected when creating a new issue.

Other Enhancements

Nginx

Silk Central is currently running NGINX 1.16.1.

NUnit3

Silk Central now supports NUnit 3 testing.

AWS

Virtual execution servers can be now deployed in AWS using a VPC, other than the default one.

System Requirements and Prerequisites

For optimal performance of Silk Central, we recommend the configuration outlined in this section.

Server System Requirements

System Area	Requirement
CPU	2 cores, Intel Core i5 or better
Memory	8 GB minimum
Free disc space	30 GB minimum, except for the database server
Network	100 Mbit
Operating system, database management system, Web server	See Tested and Supported Software.
Power Supply	Uninterruptible power supply (UPS) for all environments to reduce risks of power outages

For each additional instance, at least 10 GB of additional disk space are required, and the following initial minimal memory:

- Front-end server: 768 MB
- Application server: 640 MB
- Chart server: 200 MB

Depending on your workload, these values may need to be higher.

For more information on the ideal configuration of Silk Central, contact technical support or your technical account team.

Execution Server Requirements

The actual requirements and prerequisites for execution servers depend on the application under test (AUT) and the type of testing.

For load testing, refer to the environment requirements of Silk Performer. Running load tests with the minimal configuration can result in inaccurate results.

For functional testing, refer to the environment requirements of Silk Test. We recommend a minimum of 2048 MB main memory for intensive testing, such as Web browser replay.

The Linux execution server requires the latest version of Java Runtime Environment 1.8.

Proxy Server Requirements

If you plan to use Microsoft IIS for Silk Central, install the following IIS extensions before you install Silk Central:

- Application Request Routing (ARR)
- URL Rewrite

You can download the latest versions of these extensions on the *IIS Downloads* page.

Virtualization

Silk Central is tested to run on the virtual infrastructure environment VMware vSphere server.

Client-Side System Requirements

The manual testing UI requires the latest version of Java Runtime Environment 1.8. For manual testing with Internet Explorer 11, a 32-bit version of Java is required to be installed on the client.
