JAWS is the text-to-speech solution for blind and/ or visually impaired individuals working in the computer industry. JAWS permits a blind user to access the same functionality as a sighted user by "listening and interacting" with the user interface rather than the standard primary method of "viewing and interacting" with the user interface. With few exceptions, this product is accessible for the blind and/ or visually impaired with the use of JAWS. Additional accessibility can be added with customization of JAWS via the use of scripting and/ or frames for this product.
